Welcome To Your Workers Compensation Health Care Provider Network Program

Your insurance carrier has chosen First MCO as the workers compensation health care network certified by the State to offer a workers' compensation health care provider program. The information below is the materials needed to implement the program and help prepare you when an injury occurs.

At Time of Implementation

Post the **Workers' Compensation Panel Physicians** alongside the worksite poster in a conspicuous area visited regularly by employees such as a break room or an employee bulletin board. It is recommended (not required) to also post the general brochure provided by the New Jersey Division of Workers Compensation - "**A Worker's Guide to Workers' Compensation in New Jersey**", which is available at the links below:

At Time of Injury

1. Distribute the general brochure "**A Worker's Guide to Workers' Compensation in New Jersey**".
2. The employer has the right to direct care for the life of the claim. Please refer to the Workers' Compensation Panel Physicians for a list of providers or if you need assistance locating an in-network provider, please go to:
